#### Sea Wolf Annual membership fee

As with NZWP, you need to be a registered and financial member of Sea Wolf Water to be eligible to play for the club.

This fee is separate to training, league and tournament fees and is invoiced at the time of registration.

For 2025 the Sea Wolf registration fee is \$155

This fee covers the background running of the club as well as charges from external providers, including the Auckland Water Polo Affiliation fee.
